We are pleased to inform you that your child is ready to exit our district's ESL (English as a Second Language) program. We consider a number of criteria in determining if a student no longer needs our ESL program services. These include: a minimum score of 4.5 on the ACCESS test, the student's performance in content classes and recommendations from teachers.

Your child's level of English proficiency, as measured by the ACCESS **for ELLs** English Language Proficiency test, is _____.

The goal of the district's ESL program is to help students develop the speaking, listening, reading and writing skills they need to meet grade-level academic standards. Once students exit the program, they will no longer be entitled to accommodations such as the use of bilingual dictionaries during tests and quizzes, and extra time for assignments and tests.
