

Northern Valley Regional High School Personal Financial Literacy – Summer Options and Acknowledgement

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) currently requires all students to take the equivalent of .5 credits in ‘Financial, Economic, Business and Entrepreneurial Literacy’ or Personal Financial Literacy (PFL). Northern Valley Regional High School (NVRHS) courses that may count for this requirement are:

- Life Skills (1.0)*
- Business Organization & Management (1.0)*
- Economics (1.0)
- AP Macroeconomics and AP Microeconomics (1.0 Total)
- Personal Financial Literacy (0.5)

The Northern Valley Regional High School District is pleased to offer the following option:

NVRHS Summer School (Hybrid Course)

NVRHS offers a .5 credit PFL course to students who have completed 9th, 10th or 11th grade. The majority of this course is delivered virtually and requires students to work independently. The course is approved to run from *June 26th - July 24th, 2020*. It will have *three in-person meetings (6/26, 7/10 & 7/24 from 8:00 a.m. – 10:45 a.m.) at the Old Tappan campus (HELD VIRTUALLY IF COVID 19 REGULATIONS PROHIBIT ON-CAMPUS INSTRUCTION)*. The cost for in-district students is \$237.50 (\$475.00 out of district), which includes a \$25.00 registration fee. Registration is from *May 28th - June 7th*, and it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. [NVRHS Summer School](#)

PLEASE REVIEW THE FOLLOWING SUMMER PFL AGREEMENT

I understand that **this document is not a registration**. I am responsible to register my child for this course and to pay any tuition and fees to complete the registration.

I will abide by the agreements and expectations outlined by the organization delivering the instruction.

I understand that NVRHS may require additional, independent work to be submitted, reviewed and verified to assure alignment with New Jersey Core Curriculum Content standards.

I understand that the earned grade will appear on the transcript in all cases but it will not be calculated into the GPA. In addition, credit will be awarded if the student receives a grade of D or higher.

While I expect my child to be successful, should he or she not complete the course or receive a grade of an F, it is my responsibility to ensure that he or she will fulfill the PFL requirement prior to graduation. If my child is a rising senior, he or she may be required to drop a course scheduled for the 2020-2021 school year to accommodate the graduation requirement and the selection of that dropped course may be at the discretion of the District.

I understand that scheduling requests are completed in the Spring. If plans change, the District cannot guarantee accommodations of changes to the student’s course requests or schedule.

*Life Skills or Business Organization & Management used to satisfy the Personal Financial Literacy requirement may not be used to satisfy the **21st Century Life and Careers or Career-Technical Education** requirement simultaneously. Please see your school counselor with any questions.
