For New Credit

Personal Financial Literacy

In the Northern Valley High School District, courses taken for new credit will not be computed in class rank nor count toward grade point averages.

- Tuition fees must be paid in advance.

***Students are required to attend all 3 mandatory in-person sessions.**

Summer School Guidelines

Attendance

Summer school courses will meet for twenty two (22) days. Students are required to complete 60 hours of instruction. This requirement is necessary in order to uphold accreditation standards. **Students are required to attend all 3 in-person meetings.** The policy will be enforced regardless of the reason. Students arriving fifteen minutes late or more are absent for the day. If a student is given an Administrative Withdrawal, tuition will not be refunded.

Advanced Work

New courses meet for 2 hours and 45 minutes daily.

Examinations and Report Cards

Report cards for credit courses will be issued every twelve (11) days. The final examination for credit courses will be administered the last day of summer school. Students are asked to bring in a stamped envelope for each course they are taking, if they wish to have the report card mailed home upon the completion of summer school.

Amount of Work

For credit courses, the amount of work to be completed is the same as required during the regular school year.

Student drop-off and pick up

Students may be dropped off in front of the school prior to the beginning of class. Cars should pull up as far as possible to allow for others to clear the driveway.

Dismissal

Students taking personal financial literacy will be dismissed at 10:45am on the three days of mandatory attendance.

School Code of Conduct

- A. Tardiness as a result of bus schedules, trains, flat tires, etc. will not be excused.
- B. Students must abide by the same rules of conduct that apply within Northern Valley Regional High Schools at other times during the year.
- C. Attire may be informal and comfortable, but should be in keeping with prevailing school standards.
